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Behaviour problems in dogs can be complex in nature and in some cases might be directly or indirectly related to present or past medical conditions / pain. Therefore, it is essential that any animal displaying signs of a behavioural problem be taken for a preliminary veterinary examination. This is to check for any illness or injury, which may be causing or exacerbating the behaviour problem. Further correspondence with the referring veterinary surgeon may be required, if drug therapy would be beneficial to the behaviour modification plan, or if further diagnostic test are necessary.
